Enterprise Inland Championship
Notice of Race**

**Hosted by Ogston Sailing Club
on 30th April, 1 & 2nd May 2022**

1. Rules

The organising authority for the event will be the joint Race Committees of the host club and the Enterprise Association.

The event will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2021-2024, the International Enterprise Class Rules and the Event Specific Sailing Instructions and any amendments thereto.

2. Eligibility and Entry

The event is open to boats of the Enterprise Class. A valid measurement certificate must be available for inspection at registration. The organising authority reserves the right to carry out safety and measurement checks at any time at their discretion.

Competitors must be current members of the Enterprise Association.

Eligible boats may enter the event by completing the entry form via the association website www.sailenterprise.co.uk

3. Entry Fee

4. Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £3,000,000 for any one accident and shall sign a declaration to that effect before going afloat.

This schedule may be subject to change due to weather etc.

6. Scoring

The low points system as provided in RRS Appendix A will apply.

The Championship will comprise of a minimum of 3 races.

If 5 or more races are completed, one result shall be discarded.

If 10 races are completed, two results shall be discarded.

7. Clothing & Equipment

An approved buoyancy aid must be worn at all times whilst on the water or the jetty.

No person is allowed on the water between 1st November and 30th April (inclusive) unless protected by a wetsuit or dry suit

8. Catering

Full catering will be available throughout the weekend including breakfasts and lunches.

A BBQ dinner will be provided on the Saturday evening and a full 3 course dinner will be provided on the Sunday evening. All entrants will be provided with 2 tickets for these meals (included in the entry fee). Additional meal tickets will be available for purchase if required.

9. Liability

Competitors participate in this event entirely at their own risk. See Rule 3 – Decision to Race.

Nothing done by the organisers can reduce the responsibility of the boat nor will it make the organisers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred, as a result of the boat taking part in the racing. The organisers encompass everyone helping to run the race and the event and include the race committee, patrol boats and beach masters.

10. Advertising

There shall be no restrictions but advertising shall comply with The World Sailing Advertising Code Regulation 20. Competitors may be required to display small advertising stickers on their boats supplied by the event sponsor.

11. Other Information

Camping is available on site at no charge.

Dogs are permitted but must be on a lead at all times.
