### Event Specific Sailing Instructions

The Organising Authority is the Yorkshire Dales Sailing Club in conjunction with the Enterprise Class Association

#### 1. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

- 1.1. Notices to competitors will be posted on the Official Notice Board, situated inside the main Clubroom, opposite the galley.
- 1.2. Registration will be in the main Clubroom from 11:30 on Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> July.
- 1.3. A Competitors' Briefing will be held at 12.00 in the main Clubroom. Subsequent briefings may be held and will be advised by loudspeaker and / or on the Official Notice Board.

#### 2. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 2.1. Signals made ashore will be from the Committee Boat, alongside the pontoon.
- 2.2. When IC flag 'AP' is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 20 minutes'. This changes the meaning of AP in RRS Race Signals.

#### 3. SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 3.1. Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> July 2017, 3 races scheduled, first warning at 12:55.
- 3.2. Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2017, 2 races scheduled, first warning at 10:55.

#### 4. RACING AREA

- 4.1. The racing area will be around the club's marks.
- 4.2. Please note that there is an "out of bounds" conservation area for wildlife, in the North West corner.

#### 5. THE COURSE

- 5.1. The course will be set around the club's marks, and will be shown on the course board, which will be displayed on the front of the clubhouse, facing the water.
- 5.2. The number of laps to be sailed will be indicated on the course board.
- 5.3. Additionally, the course will be displayed on the Committee Boat when it is anchored for the start.
- 5.4. Please note that if the course is changed for a back to back race, this will only be displayed on the Committee Boat.

#### 6. MARKS

- 6.1. There are a variety of marks spread around the reservoir, and these are indicated on the course board.
- 6.2. The start will be between the Committee Boat and a mark.
- 6.3. The finish will be between the Committee Boat and a mark.
