Notice of Race

1 RULES

1.1 The event is governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2021 to 2024

1.2 The Enterprise Class rules apply.

1.3 [DP] Competitors and support persons shall comply with any reasonable request from an event official. Failure to comply may be misconduct.

Reasonable actions by event officials to implement COVID 19 guidance, protocols or legislation, even if they later prove to have been unnecessary, are not improper actions or omissions.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 The sailing instructions will be available from 01/08/2022 at www.sailenterprise.co.uk

3 COMMUNICATION

3.1 An online official notice board may be used depending on COVID 19 regulations and the location will be advised in a revision of this NoR. All notices will be pinned up at the beach masters' location by store 8 located at the bottom of the stone steps to the club house. A duplicate set may be displayed in the club house on the notice board.

3.2 [DP] While racing, except in an emergency a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communications not available to all boats. This includes mobile phones.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

4.1 The event is open to boats of the Enterprise Class whose helm is a Full or Youth member of the Enterprise Association

4.2 Competitors under 18 years of age on Sunday 21st August 2022 shall submit, with their entry form, a separate Parent/Guardian Declaration Form signed by a parent or legal guardian giving them permission to compete in the event.

4.3 Eligible boats may enter the event by completing the entry form via the association website www.sailenterprise.co.uk

4.4 To be considered as an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.



4.5 The closing deadline for receipt of entries shall be 5pm 20th August 2022.

5 FEES

5.1 Entry fees are as follows: -

5.2 If the event should be cancelled due to COVID regulations or guidance all entry fees will be refunded

6 CREW LIMITATIONS

6.1 Boats shall be crewed by 2 persons.

6.2 Substitution of the person named as helm on the entry form will not be allowed

7 ADVERTISING

7.1 Advertising shall comply with World Sailing Regulation 20. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority.

8.1 Competitors shall register with the Race Office at TENBY SAILING CLUB at times as per the Event Schedule above

8.2 A briefing may be held at approximately 20:00 on Saturday 20th August at Tenby Sailing Club and will be made available for viewing online.

8.3 No warning signal will be made after 15:00 on Friday 26th August 2022



9 EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

9.1 Each Entrant shall produce a valid measurement certificate at registration. Only certified sails may be used.

9.2 Boats may be inspected at any time during the event.

10 CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT

10.1 A competitor's clothing and equipment shall comply with RRS 50.1

10.2 RRS 40.1 shall apply at all times when afloat.

11 VENUE

11.1 Tenby Sailing Club is located at Tenby Harbour.

11.2 Racing will be held in Carmarthen Bay. Admiralty Chart Leisure South and West Wales SC5620 or Imray chart 60 Refer.

12 COURSES

12.1 The courses and starting systems will be defined in the sailing instructions.

13 PENALTY SYSTEM

13.1 Penalties shall be in accordance with RRS 44.1 & 44.2

14 SCORING

14.1 The low points scoring system of RRS Appendix A4 will apply.

14.2 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

14.3 When fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores.

14.4 When four or more races have been completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

14.5 RRS 90.3e shall apply.

15 SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS

15.1 Support boats shall register at the Race Office during registration period. During racing, support boats shall remain more than 100 metres from the course area, except when asked to assist by the Race Committee, or by explicit permission from the Race Committee.



16 BERTHING

16.1 [DP] Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while in the boat park.

17 DATA PROTECTION

17.1 The personal information you provide to the organising authority will be used to facilitate your participation in the event. If you have agreed to be bound by the Racing Rules of Sailing and the other rules that govern the event (the rules), the legal basis for processing that personal information is contract. If you are not bound by the rules, the legal basis for processing that personal information is legitimate interest. Your personal information will be stored and used in accordance with the organising authority's privacy policy. When required by the rules, personal information may be shared with the RYA, your national authority and/or World Sailing. The results of the event and the outcome of any hearing or appeal may be published.

18 RIGHTS TO USE NAMES AND LIKENESSES

18.1 Competitors participating in the 2022 Redwing Class National Championship or Enterprise Class National Championship shall be asked to give their consent on the Entry Form that their image may be used.

18.2 A drone may be flown to record video and still imagery primarily for regatta advertising and promotion.

19 RISK STATEMENT

19.1 Rule 3 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or continue racing is hers alone."

Sailing is by nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

- (a) They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure to themselves, their crew, their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part;
- (b) They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their property whether afloat or ashore;
- (c) They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
- (d) Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate
- (e) The provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the event organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
- (f) The provision of a patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances
- (g) Their boat is adequately insured, with cover of at least £5,000,000 against third party claims
- (h) It is their responsibility to familiarise themselves with any risks specific to this venue or this event drawn to their attention in any rules and information produced for the venue or event and to attend any safety briefing held for the event.



20 INSURANCE

20.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £5,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.

21 PRIZES

21.1 Daily prizes will be awarded, in the Clubhouse during the evening.

21.2 The overall series prizes will be awarded at the conclusion of the event.
